If you have any questions or need more brochures, please do not hesitate to give us a call at 261-0712. We look forward to seeing old and new faces during the months of June and July.

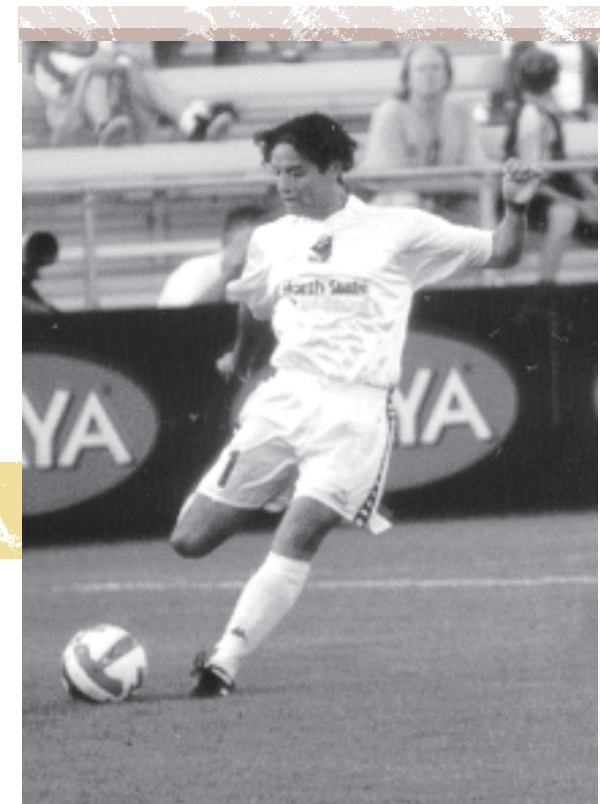
